Over a five year period, The Women's Center reaches out to thousands of women and their families, providing the following services.

Safety.

- 31,102 calls were received on the 24-hour crisis line
- 1,437 clients received services from the legal advocacy program

Shelter.

- 641 women and 748 children found safety at Sister House emergency shelter for a total of 32,693 nights of care

Support.

- 1,600 adults and 679 children received counseling and assistance from domestic violence programs and services
- 683 adults and 295 children received counseling from sexual assault programs
